Demolition and construction of facilities at the Tamalpais High School campus. It would demolish approximately 29,000 ft2 of buildings. Permanent construction would include a Music Building, Science, Math, Art Classroom Building, and Auto Shop Building. Building A, the Music Building, would be approximately 7,487 ft2, while Building B, a 4-story Science, Math & Art Classroom Building, would be approximately 30,674 ft2. Building C, the Auto Shop building, would be approximately 4,921 ft2.
