<b>POOL PLAN REVIEW FEES</b> <i>Fees are subject to change.</i>	
<small>*Unless otherwise noted, fees for application types that have time estimates are charged on a deposit basis. A technology fee surcharge of \$15 will be assessed on each permit separately from the fees in order to offset County costs associated with the permit tracking system.</small>	
<b>New or Reconstructed Pools/Spas</b> (up to 15 hrs) (Incl. pool/spa at same site) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• New pool, <b>OR</b></li> <li>• An old pool that is dug out and replaced with a new shell is considered reconstructed, <b>OR</b></li> <li>• A re-plaster, recirculation plumbing REPLACEMENT (under deck), AND <b>rebuild</b> of the shower-restroom-club house facility and/or equipment room).</li> </ul>	\$2,509
<b>Upgrade Pool/Spa</b> (up to 12 hrs) includes the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Re-plaster (Uses the existing shell), and</li> <li>• Recirculation plumbing REPLACEMENT (under deck).</li> </ul> NOTE: Fencing/Decking and MINOR equipment / facility finish improvements <i>can be included</i> .	\$1,977
<b>Re-plaster / Remodel / VGB Upgrade Pool or Spa</b> (up to 4 hrs) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Projects include: Plaster, tile and coping replacements, handrail, ladder and step replacements, splitting main drains, and minor deck and fence <u>repairs</u>.*</li> </ul>	\$659
<b>Equipment Replacement with Inspection</b> (up to 4 hrs) <b>OR rebuild of equipment rooms</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• New or Replacement of <i>2 or more significant pieces of equipment</i> (pump, filter, change disinfection, etc.) in equipment room.</li> <li>• Chemical controller installation.</li> </ul>	\$659
<b>New or Replacement of one piece of equipment <i>without inspection</i></b> (data sheet required, full plans not reqr.) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pump, filter, new style of disinfection units.</li> <li>• A set of main drain and skimmer equalizer covers. (Sketches of pools with covers located or detailed description of cover locations are required.)</li> </ul>	\$207
<b>Fence and/or Deck replacement OR Remodel ancillary facilities</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Remodel ancillary facilities, or</li> <li>• Complete replacement of entire fence* and/or deck.</li> </ul> * A separate fee is charged if a <u>complete fence replacement</u> is done at the same time as a re-plaster.	\$659
<b>Pool Plan Review – each additional hour</b> beyond base fee <b>OR Request for Service fee</b> ; <b>also use this fee for VGB covers only. One fee per site (VGB)</b>	\$207

Replacement / Repair work that does NOT require EHS pool plan review permits / fees:

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| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Equipment replacements of approved units.<br/>(Same manufacturer and same MODEL NO.)</li> <li>• Spot repairs of coping stones, tiles</li> <li>• Spot repairs of plaster</li> <li>• Spot repairs of deck</li> </ul> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Spot repairs of fencing</li> <li>• Replace heater (send EHS spec sheet)</li> <li>• Replace broken pump motor if same HP.</li> <li>• Replace flow meter (NSF-listed only)</li> <li>• Repair leaking plumbing</li> </ul> |
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
