The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the final status of the Marin County 2018 Basin Boundary Modification Request. On February 11, 2019, the Department of Water Resources (DWR) released the Final 2018 Basin Boundary Modification Results. The submitted modification request is approved.

Basin Boundary Regulations (23 CCR § 344 et seq.) specify information that must be provided by the requesting agency to support a basin boundary modification request. DWR reviewed the modification request following the methodology and criteria set forth in the regulations (23 CCR § 345 et seq.).

The request to modify the Wilson Grove Formation Highlands and Sand Point Area Basins was a jurisdictional internal type. The request included technical documents that met the requirements of the regulations and adequately supported the jurisdictional modification of the basin. Because of the approved request, the Wilson Grove Formation Highlands and Sand Point Area Basins were modified to reflect a new segment-based description supported with specific documentation as included and referenced in the request. 
