# NOTICE OF MARIN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS HEARING Inclusionary Study and Commercial Linkage Fee Study

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Marin County Board of Supervisors will hold a hearing on **Tuesday, April 18, 2023 at 9:00 a.m. or thereafter** to consider adopting two studies prepared by Community Development Agency staff. A future hearing will be held to address policy recommendations. The studies under consideration include:

#### 1. Inclusionary Study

The Inclusionary Study draws on a thorough review of current inclusionary housing policies as well as best practices. The study provides detailed analysis quantifying the affordability gap to support updated in-lieu fee calculations. The recommendations include key policy considerations for affordable housing inclusionary requirements and an associated in-lieu fee that would apply to new multi-unit developments in the Unincorporated County.

### 2. Commercial Linkage Fee Study

The Commercial Linkage Fee Study quantifies the increase in demand for affordable housing that accompanies jobs created by non-residential development. The study draws on analysis of the gap between what households can afford to pay for housing and the cost of developing new housing units. The resulting recommendation is an updated Commercial Linkage Fee that would apply to all new non-residential development in the Unincorporated County.

#### **Board of Supervisors Hearing**

On April 18, 2023 at 9:00 a.m. or thereafter, the Board of Supervisors will review and discuss the studies described above and will consider them for adoption.
