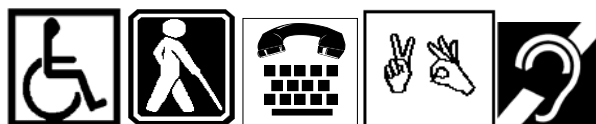

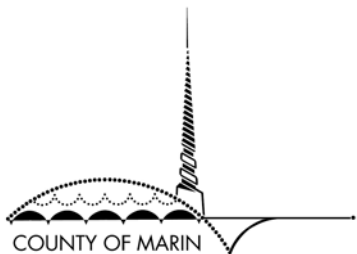

The meeting commenced at 6:00 P.M.

1. Minutes.

The minutes were accepted from March 26, 2014.

2. Discuss Next Community Workshop on June 5, 2014.

Staff discussed the proposed format of the next community workshop scheduled for June 5, 2014 and asked advisory committee members to provide ideas on displays and information at the booths/stations to obtain input and feedback. Staff requested committee members reach out to their neighbors and friends in the community to spread the word about the next workshop and invite them to attend and provide their input and feedback.

3. Discuss Public Access on Paper Streets.

Staff provided a draft map showing the locations of potential paper streets as well as county maintained streets in the community. Discussion followed on potential areas for public access, such as Crest and Glen Roads. A question was raised regarding how to determine whether a road is abandoned. Staff will email a copy of the map to committee members and asked committee members to call out those paper streets that should be prioritized in the community plan to protect or maintain for public access purposes.

4. Review Draft Outline of Community Plan.

Staff reviewed a preliminary draft of the proposed community plan. Advisory committee members suggested including an section of just the policies; include a discussion and map of the baylands corridor; and the environmental hazards section should also include the topic of earthquakes. Other suggestions included the idea of merging the Community Character and Design section and Community Development and Land Use sections, as well as describing how freight train service is used on the NWPRR right-of-way in the Transportation section. A potential trail connection to Rush Creek was suggested along the north side of Atherton Avenue from Bugei to Olive Avenue.
