Design Review Recommendation: Agenda Item 1 - Nishiguchi/Callinan Residence Review

Presenters: Nathan & Megan Nishiguchi (owners), Christian Oaks (architect) & Pete Peterson (landscape architect)

The presenters offered drawings and building materials for review. The site is a hillside lot with existing neighboring homes adjacent and across the street. Design details include,

- Massing to be similar to adjacent neighbors with three levels stepped to mimic the contours of the hillside
- Setbacks are behind neighbor homes

- No major viewing angles from neighbors are blocked
- Owners noted that they talked to the adjacent neighbors and took their concerns into account
- Building materials include cement plaster (light brown), standing seam metal roof (dark brown color), aluminum window frames (bronze), Hubarton light fixture (bronze), garage door with translucent glass panels and grey tinted glazing for windows and guardrails
- Wood siding on the west façade natural color
- Solar panels on roof
- No play structures
- Utilities underground
- Walkway and entry area include stone accents
- Exterior downlights would be located at walkways and backyard areas
- Planters and guardrails would be light earthtone colored

Tom Kale, from area homeowners association, said he wholeheartedly approves of the design.

Comments from SDRB members include,

- Exterior lighting to be dark sky type (JW)
- Solar panels to not be seen from street (JW)
- Side yard fence could be better articulated to match overall design of home (JW & NA)
