Jason Osborne presented project:

- Existing pole could not accommodate 3 important factors: structural, climbing space needed and capacity (there is huge demand for data)
- Tried looking at alternative spaces and decided it was better to expand existing area
- New pole to be 8' higher than existing pole to achieve line of sight requirements and painted textured brown
- New pole to be near existing trees and near adjacent poles
- Goal to build for future internet/telecommunications growth needs for the surrounding and Strawberry area
