- III. Comments to the Planning Staff
 - 1. Neighbor Judith Flynn was present to express concerns over open patio area and noise during the weekends or at night.
 - 2. Adam Winig presented to the board the new 2-story pool house for the Strawberry Rec Center.

SRDB COMMENTS

Joe Sherer: Would like to see story poles at four highest points with flags and tape. He has concerns about parking (no additional parking is proposed). Noise on deck is a concern for neighbors and is concerned that North side's roof (LED's) on 2^{nd} floor not necessary and would cause glare.

Matt Williams: Solar panels aren't shown in elevation drawings and would like drawings to be more accurate/clear. Would like to see clarification of lighting on outdoor deck area.

Julie Brown: Recommended restraint in lighting overall. Suggested reducing external lighting on upper floor on North side. Agreed that story poles were needed for public's full disclosure/understanding.

Penna Omega: Is concerned about the condition of the existing steps from Ricardo Road to elevator, which will be used drastically more often to access the 2nd story area. Agrees that lighting on 2nd floor is problem, possible alternative would be 3 canned lights where cement beams are shown in drawings between windows. Would like applicant to consider more benches in bathroom areas for changing clothes.

Motion to CONTINUE project to May 7th as presented as submitted by Julie Brown, seconded by Matt Williams:

Recommendation of (a) story poles erected by May 1 with corners linked with flags and tape for communities understanding of massing (b) removing exterior lighting at North side 2nd floor (c) SRD continue aggressive parking & event management to mitigate potential impact of additional square footage activity, and (d) further attention to locker room usage for families with young children during design development.
