As required by Section 2279 of the California Agricultural Code, I herewith submit the 1972 Annual Livestock and Agricultural Crop Report for the County of Marin.

The combined livestock industry continues to represent about 90% of the total gross agricultural value of the county, of which nearly 66% is derived from milk production alone.

Certain categories are combined where the production is either of minor importance or it is necessary to protect the interest of producers of entire crops. The retail sales figure in nursery production is for informative purposes only, and is not included in production totals.

The figures presented in this report represent the gross value of agricultural production and do not reflect net income to the growers.

I wish to express my appreciation to the farmers, producers, and the County Farm Advisor for their cooperation in compilation of these figures, as well as to the personnel of the Department who were instrumental in gathering and compiling the information contained herein.
