	<p>Short term goal of receiving data on how the policies are being used.</p> <p>Elise agrees that ATOD is moving in the right direction, particularly in terms of having sub goals in ATOD that work with CMCA</p> <p>Educational Equity is looking at building a coalition with other groups like Marin Promise, surveys showed that young people are not aware of A-G policies but in many cases they think they do.</p> <p>Want to expand relationships with Principals Possibly creating a policy that counselors must let students know or assemblies</p> <p>Wendy likes how specific Educational Equity goals are Noah suggests working with Student Services Director</p> <p>Presidential Election Discussion (15 minutes) Confusion on how someone like Donald Trump could be a mainstream candidate, Noah commented how some people have described it as the last “cry” from the white majority of the country</p> <p>Another question on if Trump becomes President how could this affect individuals Jonathan speaks on how a Trump presidency would primarily impact national minorities in the country, whether that be People of Color, LGBTQ+, Muslims or otherwise.</p> <p>Florida projected by AP to go to Trump, this was a surprise to Jonathan and many others Ohio went to Trump-Not surprising according to Jonathan, this was expected and he is still confident Clinton will win presidency.</p> <p>Wendy comments as states are being called for Trump that she is surprised yet she feels she shouldn't be.</p>
