	 a family of drugs that are usually prescribed for pain, but can include street drugs the leading cause of accidental deaths in Marin County Overdose Education Fentanyl Education powerful drug that can be mass produced and readily available fentanyl is 50 times stronger than heroin Preventing Overdose deaths with Narcan narcan is an "opioid antagonist" What does narcan do? reverses opioid poisoning in minutes repeated doses may be necessary Narcan training recognize an overdose and call 911 perform rescue breathing administer narcan aftercare Marin's response Spahr center distributed narcan RxSafe Marin How our community can help safe drug disposal prevent overdose deaths treatment for opioid addiction
