

The Marin County Environmental Health Services (EHS) has reviewed the *Marin County MED-Project Stewardship Plan (Plan)* dated January 29, 2017 for compliance with the Marin County Safe Drug Disposal Ordinance, Chapter 7.90. The Plan is approved.

Within six months after the end of the first 12-month period of the Stewardship Plan Operation, and annually thereafter, the Plan Operator of a Stewardship Plan shall submit a report to the Director on behalf of participating Producers describing the Plan's activities during the previous reporting period (Section 7.90.110).
