## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

## DRAFT BLACK POINT COMMUNITY PLAN DRAFT GREEN POINT COMMUNITY PLAN

WHO: Any and all interested persons.

**WHAT:** The Marin County Planning Commission will conduct a public hearing to consider both the Draft Black Point Community Plan and the Draft Green Point Community Plan.

On March 8, 2016, the Marin County Board of Supervisors directed staff to prepare separate community plans for both the Black Point and Green Point communities. The proposed Draft Green Point Community Plan is based on the 1978 Black Point Community Plan, while the proposed Draft Black Point Community Plan is based on the Planning Commission Recommended Draft of the Black Point/Green Point Communities Plan.

Both the Black Point and Green Point communities are unincorporated areas of 307 and 1,124 acres, respectively. The neighboring communities are located in the northeastern portion of Marin County adjacent to the Petaluma River at its entrance to San Pablo Bay, and are bisected by State Route 37. Both community plans provide guidance on issues unique to each community. The proposed Black Point Community Plan addresses the topics of natural resources, environmental hazards, community character and land use, transportation, public facilities and services, parks and recreation, and public safety. The proposed Green Point Community Plan focuses on issues related to marsh and wetlands, sanitation, roads, public transportation, and equestrian trails.

WHERE: The public hearing will be held in the Marin County Hearing Chambers, Room 328/330,

Administration Building, Civic Center, San Rafael, California.

WHEN: Monday, May 23, 2016
