## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

## 2016 BLACK POINT COMMUNITY PLAN 2016 GREEN POINT COMMUNITY PLAN

WHO: Any and all interested persons, including residents in Green Point and Black Point.

**WHAT:** The Marin County Board of Supervisors will conduct a public hearing to consider both the 2016 Black Point Community Plan and the 2016 Green Point Community Plan.

On March 8, 2016, the Marin County Board of Supervisors directed staff to prepare separate community plans for both the Black Point and Green Point communities. The 2016 Black Point Community Plan is based on the former Planning Commission Recommended Draft of the Black Point/Green Point Communities Plan, while the 2016 Green Point Community Plan is based on the 1978 Black Point Community Plan. On May 23, 2016 the Marin County Planning Commission recommended the Board of Supervisors adopt the 2016 Black Point Community Plan and the 2016 Green Point Community Plan.

Both the Black Point and Green Point communities are unincorporated areas of approximately 307 and 1,124 acres, respectively. The neighboring communities are located in the northeastern portion of Marin County adjacent to the Petaluma River at its entrance to San Pablo Bay, and are divided by State Route 37. Both community plans provide guidance on issues unique to each community. The 2016 Black Point Community Plan addresses the topics of natural resources, environmental hazards, community character and land use, transportation, public facilities and services, parks and recreation, and public safety. The 2016 Green Point Community Plan focuses on issues related to its geologic setting, marsh and wetlands, land use and zoning, affordable housing, recreation, sanitation, roads, public transportation, and equestrian trails.

WHERE: The public hearing will be held in the Marin County Hearing Chambers, Room 328/330,

Administration Building, Civic Center, San Rafael, California.

WHEN: Tuesday, July 26, 2016 at 1:30 pm.

If you challenge the decision on this application in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Community Development Agency, Planning Division during or prior to the public hearing. (Government Code Section 65009(b)(2).
