NOTICE OF MARIN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS PUBLIC HEARING

BOARD DIRECTION TO STAFF REGARDING THE FUTURE PROCESS OF THE UPDATE OF THE 1978 BLACK POINT COMMUNITY PLAN AND THE DRAFT BLACK POINT/GREEN POINT COMMUNITIES PLAN

WHO: Any and all interested persons.

WHAT: The Board of Supervisors will conduct a public hearing to consider a

recommendation from the Marin County Planning Commission to adopt the Draft Black Point/Green Point Communities Plan. The Black Point and Green Point community is an unincorporated area of about 1,560 acres located in the northeastern edge of Marin County adjacent to the Petaluma River at its entrance to San Pablo Bay. The Black Point/Green Point Communities Plan is a document which identifies issues of importance to the community and provides additional guidance and policies related to natural resources, environmental hazards, community character and land use, transportation, public facilities and services, parks and recreation, and public safety. The Draft Black Point/Green Point Communities Plan is an update to the 1978 Black Point Community Plan.

A group of residents from the Green Point area have proposed that the County prepare a separate community plan for Green Point as an alternative approach to the Planning Commission Recommended Draft of the Black Point/Green Point Communities Plan. As provided in the adopted Community Plan Update Strategy, significant changes to the scope of a community planning process require approval of the Marin County Board of Supervisors; therefore, the Board is expected to consider alternatives to the Planning Commission recommendation, including but not limited to, Green Point's request to separate the community plan.

WHERE: The public hearing will be held in the Marin County Hearing Chambers, Room

328/330, Administration Building, Civic Center, San Rafael, California.

WHEN: Tuesday, March 8, 2016 at 1:30 pm.

If you challenge the decision on this application in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Community Development Agency, Planning Division during or prior to the public hearing.
