Last fall, almost overnight with no public notice, red flashing beacons were installed on six PG&E towers on the east and west sides of the Petaluma River in Black Point.

Many of us are livid that the beacons are shining in our windows all night long. While the towers are on the flats, Black Point homes are on hills so beacons shine directly into our homes. Many do not have blinds as we enjoy our previously dark sky community. Not only are the beacons intrusively bright but the flash every three seconds.

The beacons are two miles from Gnoss Airport at 200 feet elevation. Any pilot flying that low should not have a license. There has never been an accident along the Petaluma River.

In desperation, I wrote to Senator Boxer for help stating in my claim, "These beacons may be required by the FAA but why now? Gnoss Air
