Project Description:

The applicant requests Design Review approval to construct an approximately 1,080-square-foot detached accessory structure in a developed lot in Mill Valley. The proposed project would result in 4,617 square feet of development and in a floor area ratio of 25.79 percent on the 17,900-square-foot lot. The proposed accessory structure would reach a maximum height of 14 feet 11 inches above surrounding grade and the exterior walls would have the following setbacks: 35 feet nine inches from the western front property line; five feet one inch from the southern side property line; 15 feet ten inches from the northern side property line; and over 100 feet from the eastern rear property line. Various site improvements would also be entailed in the proposed development, including landscape, hardscape improvements and conversion of the resultant accessory structure to an Accessory Dwelling Unit.

Design Review approval is required pursuant to Marin County Code (MCC) Section 22.20.090.1.b. because the project proposes to place an accessory structure within the required side yard setback. Further, Design Review approval is required under MCC Section 22.42.020.B because construction of the proposed project would result in more than 3,500 square feet of floor area in the RA-B2 Zoning District.
