Exemptions

The following exemptions have been issued during the 3rd quarter of 2016:

7/1/2016, Product Name: Fresh Cab Balsam fir oil rodent repellent. This exemption
was requested by the Department of Public Works to trial as a possible replacement for
EVAC which has been discontinued by the manufacturer. The active ingredient is
Balsam Fir Oil and comes in individual pouches. The pouches are installed in the
engine compartments of County fleet vehicles to deter rodents from entering and
causing damage to the vehicle wiring systems. This product is an EPA 25B exempt
product due to its organic nature.

Violations

 On September 15, 2016, Staff at Stafford Lake Park found 4 empty 12 oz bottles of Ortho Poison Ivy control in the garbage can on the Disc Golf Course hole #8. Staff did not witness any application being made, nor were they able to locate the treated/affected area in follow up. It is likely that a rouge golfer took it upon themselves to bring in the ready to use product and make an application to poison oak growing adjacent to and possibly encroaching onto one of the tee boxes or holes along the course.
