


# **COMMUNITY WORKSHOP** Road and Trail Designation

#### The Marin County Open Space District is hosting a community workshop on Region 4 road and trail system designation.

- Verissimo Hills

Learn how public proposals are integrated into annual road and trail management planning, including the baseline scores and criteria used for evaluation. The Marin County Open Space District manages 16,000 acres of public lands across Marin County

Get information about the application process which allows members of the public to suggest changes to the proposed designated road and trail system, including recommended timelines and deadlines for submitting.

The Marin County Open Space District approved the Road and Trail Management Plan (RTMP) in 2014. The purpose of the plan is to establish a road and trail system that is sustainable, safe, enjoyable, and reduces environmental impact.
