INVITING SEALED PROPOSALS OF BIDS

Sealed Proposals will be received by the Marin County Parks, Marin County Civic Center, 3501 Civic Center Drive, Room 260, San Rafael, California 94903, until **2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, March 29, 2016**. Proposals will be opened and read in Room No. 260 for:

**SITE FURNISHINGS
REPLACEMENT PROJECT – PHASE 1**

Work shall be done in accordance with official plans and specifications, which are available at Marin County Parks, Room 260, Civic Center, San Rafael, California, and may be purchased for **\$50.00** per set (non-refundable). There will be a \$12.00 service fee for returned checks. Mailed requests shall be addressed to the Marin County Parks, 3501 Civic Center Drive, Room 260, San Rafael, California 94903. Project Description: This project involves the removal and installation of new park furnishings within the Marin County Park system. This is the first phase of a larger effort to restore the County's parks through Measure A funding passed in 2012. Site furnishings include benches, receptacles, picnic tables, hot coal bins, and drinking fountains. In addition the project will include the demolition and removal of existing furnishings, footings, as well as the installation of new elements including, but not limited to: concrete pads, stabilized decomposed granite and asphalt.

The Engineer's Estimate for this project is: \$158,500.

A contractor or subcontractor shall not be qualified to bid on, be listed in a bid proposal, subject to the requirements of Section 4104 of the Public Contract Code, or engage in the performance of any contract for public work, as defined in this chapter, unless currently registered and qualified to perform public work pursuant to Section 1725.5 of the Labor Code. It is not a violation of this section for an unregistered contractor to submit a bid that is authorized by Section 7029.1 of the Business and Professions Code or by Section 10164 or 20103.5 of the Public Contract Code, provided the contractor is registered to perform public work pursuant to Section 1725.5 of the Labor Code at the time the contract is awarded. This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations.

A Bid Bond in the amount of 10% of the total bid amount payable to the County of Marin shall accompany the Proposal. (Bidder's security can be in the form of cash, a cashier's check, a certified check or a bidder's bond from Contractor's Surety Company.)

Award of contract, if awarded, will be to the lowest responsible bidder whose proposal complies with prescribed requirements, and will be within thirty (30) days after receipt of proposals.

The County of Marin reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The provisions of Public Contract Code 22300, regarding substitution of securities for monies withheld to ensure performance shall apply to this contract.

A pre-bid meeting will be held on **Tuesday, March 22, 2016 at 10:00AM** at McInnis Park (skatepark shelter), 310 Smith Ranch Road, San Rafael, CA. It is highly recommended that the Contractor visit the project sites prior to the pre-bid meeting.

The Contractor shall possess a valid C-27 License at the time contract is awarded.

Bids are required for the entire work described herein. This contract is subject to state contract nondiscrimination and compliance requirements pursuant to Government Code, Section 12990.

The County of Marin hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business and woman owned business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color or national origin in consideration for an award.

Pursuant to Section 1773 of the Labor Code, the general prevailing wage rates for Marin County where the work is to be done have been determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations. These wages are set forth in the General Prevailing Wage Rates for this project, available at the Department of Public Works.
