CONDITIONS OF PERMIT

1. All other permits from other agencies pertinent to the work in Item-3 above shall be obtained prior to commencement of work. Applicants are encouraged to contact Marin County Department of Public Works at (415) 473-6530 or at www.mcstoppp.org for other pertinent agency information.
2. The issued permit is only valid when signed by the Director or designated official of Marin County Department of Public Works. Applicants are encouraged to contact Flood Control and/or Land Development at (415) 473-6549 during the project-planning phase.
3. The permit shall be available at the work site at all times.
4. Work shall be conducted in such manner as to minimize dust, debris, noise and impact to the creek.
5. Permittee shall be responsible for cleaning and repair of damage to the surrounding areas resulting from the work.
6. Permittee shall implement an approved creek protection plan as further specified in Special Conditions included with the permit.

*Perennial flows year around; intermittent flows throughout winter; ephemeral flows during rain events only. All three types require permits.
