Voters can vote in person at the election office, 3501 Civic Center Dr., Room 121 until 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.

Election Day is Tuesday, Nov. 8, 2011. Polls and ROV office open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

Estimated turnout is 38-40%. About 70% of this turnout will be from vote by mail voters.

**Results**

- Results of vote by mail ballots returned before November 8 will be available shortly after 8:00 p.m. on Election Night.
- First report from precincts expected at approximately 9:30 p.m. election night. Precinct results will be updated approximately every ½ hour thereafter until all ballots are returned from the polls (approximately 11:00 p.m.)
- Results will be updated every Friday by 5:00 p.m., and will be posted to the ROV website [www.marinvotes.org](http://www.marinvotes.org). Friday, Nov. 11 is a holiday, so results will be updated by Tuesday of the following week. Election will be certified by Tuesday, December 6.
