PLEASE NOTE: To qualify as a poll worker you must be either a registered voter in California or a permanent legal resident of the U.S. aged 18 and over *, or a high school senior who is at least 16 years old. **Being an elections officer requires a solid commitment** to be at the polling location **before, during and after** the polls are open (7 a.m. - 8 p.m.) on election day. **IT IS A LONG DAY**; from approximately 6 a.m. – 9 p.m. Breaks are provided throughout the day. Poll workers must also be able to read and write English.

*If you are a permanent legal resident of the U.S., you are eligible to work as a clerk only.
