- Put down roots in a permanent space with a vibrant public commons
- Level the playing field for small farmers and local food producers, especially producers who are BIPOC, LGBTQ+ people, women, immigrants, and veterans.
- Increase community access and education to quality, nutrient-dense foods for all
- Offer community resilience in changing climate conditions



MAJOR FEATURES

- Year-round certified farmers market 3 days per week (Tue-Thur-Sun); 250 stalls; onsite chef and vendor parking
- New market amenities ADA friendly restrooms, seating, drinking water, tiedowns for producers' tents, and shelter from sun, rain, and wind
- Visitor center with market information,
 exhibitions, merchandise, and coffee kiosk
- Demo kitchen, outdoor classrooms, and conference rooms



CLIMATE IMPACT

- Endorsed by the MarinCAN (formerly Marin Drawdown Project) as one of seven countywide solutions for reducing greenhouse gases (GHGs):
- Anticipated two years to achieve net-positive energy!
- Foundation of **eco-concrete** and **permeable pavers**
- Fully electric with on-site solar panels
- On-site composting and carbon sequestration garden
- Pollinator corridor for essential life-giving insects and birds
- Rainwater cistern for on-site irrigation
- Closed-loop waste and water management


