I am pleased to submit the 1983 Annual Livestock and Agricultural Crop Report for the County of Marin, as required by Section 2279 of the California Food and Agricultural Code.

The combined livestock industry represents about 91% of the total gross agricultural value of the county, of which nearly 68% is derived from milk production alone.

Certain categories are combined where production is either of minor importance or necessary to protect the interest of producers of entire crops. The <u>figures presented in this report represent the gross value</u> of agricultural production and do <u>not reflect net income</u> to the growers.
