**REQUIREMENTS FOR DECLARATION OF CANDIDACY FOR A PARTISAN OFFICE (including County Central Committees)**

No declaration of candidacy for a partisan office or for membership on a county central committee shall be filed by a candidate unless:

(1) at the time of presentation of the declaration and continuously for not less than three months immediately prior to that time, or for as long as he/she has been eligible to register to vote in the state, the candidate is shown by his/her affidavit of registration to be affiliated with the political party the nomination for which he/she seeks. A candidate can be registered as "declines to state" the 9 months previous to the 3-month period; and

(2) the candidate has not been registered as affiliated with a qualified political party other than that political party the nomination of which he/she seeks within 12 months, or, in the case of an election governed by Chapter 7 (commencing with Section 7200), within three months immediately prior to the filing of the declaration. (Elections Code §8001)

Qualifications - Candidate must be a registered voter of the county at the time that nomination papers are issued. No person is eligible to become a candidate for the office of sheriff unless, at the time of the final filing date for election, he or she meets one of the following criteria:

- 1) An active or inactive advanced certificate issued by the Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training; or
- 2) One year of full-time, salaried law enforcement experience within the provisions of Section 830.1 or 830.2 of the Penal Code, at least a portion of which shall have been accomplished within five years prior to the date of filing, and possesses a master's degree from an accredited college or university; or
- 3) Two years of full-time, salaried law enforcement experience within the provisions of Section 830.1 or 830.2 of the Penal Code at least a portion of which shall have been accomplished within five years prior to the date of filing, and possess a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university; or
- 4) Three years of full-time, salaried law enforcement experience within the provisions of Section 830.1 or 830.2 of the Penal Code at least a portion of which shall have been accomplished within five years prior to the date of filing, and possess an Associate in Arts or Associate in Science degree, or the equivalent, from an accredited college; or
- 5) Four years of full-time, salaried law enforcement experience within the provisions of Section 830.1 or 830.2 of the Penal Code at least a portion of which shall have been accomplished within five years prior to the date of filing, and possess a high school diploma or the equivalent.

All persons holding the office of sheriff on January 1, 1989 shall be deemed to have met all qualifications required for candidates seeking election or appointment to the office of sheriff. (Govt. Code §24001 and §24004.3)
