# Background

- •The existing fixed height simple lectern used by the public during BOS and Planning Commission meetings is aged, not ADA compliant, and not suitable for those of short stature.
- •Due to recent furniture advancements, a new ADA compliant motorized sit-stand lectern is being proposed. The size is 46" W x 30" D and can adjust to heights of 38"-46".





#### ADA Lectern Features

- Push button up-down table controls.
- Digital timer, microphone, power outlet can be installed on table.
- •Several plastic laminate or veneer wood options to choose from.
- Table/backsplash and edge banding can be a different colored laminate (to be confirmed).
- •This lectern has been approved by the County's Disability Access Manager
- •Lectern is on casters and can be moved.










### Lectern Location




Masking tape indicates location and size of new lectern.
