Sample Annual Notification Letter **For Schools Using Only Exempt Pesticides**

(Must go to all parents, guardians, and staff and can be sent with other school communications at the beginning of the year)

Dear Parent, Guardian, or Staff Member,

The Healthy Schools Act of 2000 requires each school district to notify parents, guardians, and staff annually of pesticides the district expects to apply during the year. We have been working hard to adopt integrated pest management (IPM) practices in our district, and <u>this year we will only use pesticides in forms that are exempt from notification and posting under the Healthy Schools Act</u>.

The Act grants these IPM practices exemption from notification and posting because they pose little hazard to the public. The code section 17610.5, which grants this exemption, was developed to reward schools that adopt IPM and use least toxic products. We have listed the pesticides below, but since they are exempt, we will not send out notification each time we use them.
