**Project Title:** Bike Park Maintenance

**Project Location:** Stafford Lake Park. Unincorporated Marin County, vicinity of City of Novato, California

**Assessor's Parcel:** 125-090-19

**Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of the Project:** Marin County Parks is proposing to perform routine maintenance of the existing bike park at the kids pump track and beginner pump track with the purpose of restoring the original height of the berms and rollers and restoring positive drainage. The berms and rollers have degraded over time due to weather and use. No changes would be made to the configuration of the bike park. Approximately 400 yards of stockpiled fill would be used to restore the height of the berms and rollers. Equipment would include two mini excavators, a track loader, and a plate compactor. Equipment access and staging would occur along existing paved roads and the existing parking area. Marin County Parks would implement standard dust control Best Management Practices during implementation of the proposed project. No wetlands or surface waters would be affected by implementation of the proposed project and no regulatory permit authorizations would be required. Marin County Parks would implement standard dust control Best Management Practices during implementation of the proposed project. The bike park and the shade structure area would be closed during project implementation, which is expected to be complete by April 20, 2022.

**Reasons for Exemption:** Marin County Parks has reviewed the proposed project along with its environmental setting and has determined it to be categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act under the following section of the California Administrative Code:

**Section 15301: Existing Facilities.** The proposed project consists of the routine maintenance of the existing bike park at Stafford Lake Park, a public facility, and would involve negligible or no expansion of existing or former use. Implementation of the proposed project would not result in cumulative impacts; significant impacts on the environment due to unusual circumstances; or affect the significance of historical resources. The project is not located within an officially designated scenic highway or on a hazardous waste site pursuant to Government Code Section 65962.5.
