**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE 2019 FIRE ACCESS IMPROVEMENT PROJECT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE AND AWARD THE CONSTRUCTION PROJECT; ADJUST THE FY 19/20 PROJECT BUDGET AND ACCEPTING CEQA NOTICE OF EXEMPTION**

**WHEREAS**, the plans and specifications for the 2019 Fire Access Improvement Project are hereby approved; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council approved the Fire Access Improvement Project in the 2018/2019 and 2019/20 budgets; and

**WHEREAS**, the 2019 Fire Access Improvement Project is funded through Municipal Service Tax, and General Funds; and

**WHEREAS**, a Notice of Exemption will be filed with the County Recorder's office to demonstrate status as a Categorical Exemption pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act; and


**WHEREAS**, the Mill Valley Municipal Code Section 2.56.010.F authorizes City Council to award the contract by resolution.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Mill Valley, having considered all evidence in the public record, does hereby resolve, declare, determine and order that:

1. The City Council approves the Plans and Specifications for 2019 Fire Access Improvement Project
2. The City Manager is authorized to advertise and award bid to the lowest responsive/responsible bidder.
3. Allocate \$200,000 from FY 19/20 design budget into the FY 19/20 construction budget
4. The City Council accepts the CEQA Notice of Exemption.
