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

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILL VALLEY APPROVING THE PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS AND ESTIMATE FOR THE 2022 MISCELLANEOUS ADA CURB RAMP UPGRADES PROJECT; FINDING THE PROJECT EXEMPT FROM CEQA; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO AWARD AND EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO LOWEST QUALIFIED RESPONSIVE AND RESPONSIBLE BIDDER FOR CONSTRUCTION

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILL VALLEY HEREBY FINDS AND RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The plans and specifications for the 2022 Miscellaneous ADA Curb Ramp Upgrades Project are hereby approved.

SECTION 2. The budget specifies and includes funds for the project.


