A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILL VALLEY APPROVING THE PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS AND ESTIMATE FOR THE CAMINO ALTO AND SYCAMORE AVENUE TRAFFIC SIGNAL REPLACEMENT PROJECT; FINDING THE PROJECT EXEMPT FROM CEQA; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO AWARD AND EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO LOWEST QUALIFIED RESPONSIVE AND RESPONSIBLE BIDDER FOR CONSTRUCTION

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILL VALLEY HEREBY FINDS AND RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The plans and specifications for the Camino Alto and Sycamore Traffic Signal Replacement Project are hereby approved.

SECTION 2. The budget specifies and includes funds for the project.

SECTION 3. The City's General Plan directs to enhance capacity and improve efficiency at key intersections and maintain a well-connected pedestrian and bicycle system that is accessible, easy to navigate, and comfortable for all types of users.

SECTION 4. The Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee and residents have provided comments on the design.

SECTION 5. A Notice of Exemption will be filed with the County Recorder's office to demonstrate project status as Categorical Exemption pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act.

SECTION 6. The City Manager is hereby authorized to award and execute contract to the lowest qualified, responsive, and responsible bidder for construction.
