- 1. **Project Name:** Whitehouse Pool Sediment Removal Project;
- 2. **Project Location:** Unincorporated Marin
- 3. **Project Description:** At milepost 25.00 of Sir Francis Drake Boulevard, perform culvert maintenance to clear the clogged double box culvert under the roadway and remove excess sediment from associated channels upstream and downstream of the culvert. Project includes clearing approximately 970 lineal feet of channel in Silver Hills Creek and Old Bear Valley Creek, clearing of vegetation for access and restoration of disturbed areas.
