Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of the Project: The proposed project consists of granting a special use permit to LGC Biosearch Technologies for the LGC Biosearch Tehcnologies Summer BBQ at the Stafford Lake Park Areas 1 and 2 reservables site and approximately 300 parking spaces. The event would occur on August 18, 2023 between 12:00 PM and 3:30 PM. Set-up would occur between 10:00 AM and 12:00 PM, and take down would occur immediately following the event. Approximately 600 participants are anticipated. The event would include amplified sound.

Name of Person or Agency Carrying Out the Project: Max Korten, Director and General Manager

Reasons for Exemption: Marin County Parks has reviewed the special event permit application in the context of Stafford Lake Park and has determined that authorizing the permit the event is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act under the following sections of the California Administrative Code:

Section 15323: Normal Operations of Facilities for Public Gatherings. The project consists issuing a special event permit at an existing facility for a public gathering. Stafford Lake Park was designed with reservable space for this type of event and there is a past history of this facility being used for this purpose. There is a reasonable expectation that this event would not represent a change in the operation of the facility and that the event would not result in cumulative impacts; significant impacts on the environment due to unusual circumstances; affect the significance of historical resources. The project is not located within an officially designated scenic highway or on a hazardous waste site pursuant to Government Code Section 65962.5.
