Business and Professions Code 22351. Certificate of Registration of a Process Server

- (a) The certificate of registration of a registrant who is a natural person shall contain the following:
 - (1) Name, age, mailing address and telephone number of the registrant.
 - (2) Statement, signed by the registrant under penalty of perjury, that the registrant has not been convicted of a felony.
 - (3) Statement that registrant has been a resident of this state for a period of one year immediately preceding the filing of the certificate.
 - (4) Statement that registrant will perform duties in compliance with the provision of law governing the service of process in this state.
- (b) The certificate of registration of a registrant who is a partnership of corporation shall contain the following:
 - (1) The names, ages, addresses and telephone numbers of the general partners or officers.
 - (2) A statement signed under penalty of perjury that the general partners or officers have not been convicted of a felony.
 - (3) A statement that partnership or corporation has been organized and existed continuously for a period of one year immediately preceding the filing of certificate; or, a responsible employee, partner or officer has been previously registered under this chapter.
 - (4) A statement by partnership or corporation that it will perform its duties under compliance with the provisions of law governing the service of process in this state.

Business and Professions Code 22351.5 Fingerprints

- (a) At the time of filing an initial certificate of registration, late renewal or reinstating a revoked registration, the registrant shall submit fingerprints for submission to the Department of Justice and the Federal Bureau of Investigation, in order to verify that the registrant has not been convicted of a felony. Please call for Live Scan Authorization and appointment information.
- (b) If the clerk is advised that the registrant has been convicted of a felony, the presiding judge of the Superior Court of the county in which the certificate of registration is maintained is authorized to review the criminal record and notify the registrant that the registration is revoked.

Business and Professions Code 22352 Fees

At the time of filing the initial certificate of registration, a registrant shall pay the following fees to the county clerk:

- (a) A registration filing fee for One Hundred Seventeen Dollars (\$117).
- (b) A fee to cover the actual cost of recording the bond.
- (c) A fee for processing completed fingerprint cards (if live scan was not utilized) when submitted with the initial certificate of registration.

HOW TO REGISTER AS A PROCESS SERVER

- Complete the Certificate of Registration
- Obtain a Bond for a Process Server from a bonding company. The bond amount is \$2000 and it covers the two year registration period. The bond should commence the day you file the Certificate with the County Clerk and be effective for the two years of your registration. You will sign the bond as principal when it is filed in the County Clerk's office.
- If you are a new process server, or filing after an expiration date, you must submit your fingerprints for a felony conviction search. You may call for a 'Live Scan' appointment in the Marin County Sheriff's Office at (415) 473-7286, or the Marin City Sheriff's Sub-Station at (415) 332-5422. Prior to your live scan appointment, you must obtain a Live Scan Request Form from the Clerk's office by calling (415) 473-6416. You will pay a total of \$56.00 to the Department of Justice for this service together with the live scan fee charged by the Sheriff.
- If you or any corporate officer has ever been convicted of a felony, present a copy of certificate of rehabilitation, expungement or pardon.

- Proof of Live Scan fingerprint completion
- \$117.00 Filing Fee (\$100 filing fee, \$10 ID card fee, and \$7 file stamp the bond fee)
- \$14.00 Bond Recording Fee (if bond is in a standard format-1 front page or add \$3.00 for each additional page)
- \$12.00 Additional identification Card fee (if required)
