#### **NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF DRAFT 2022 CONSOLIDATED ANNUAL PERFORMANCE AND EVALUATION REPORT (CAPER)**

As a condition of continued federal funding for certain housing, capital, and public service programs, the Marin County Community Development Agency is required to submit a Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report (CAPER) on the County's progress toward meeting the goals established by the Marin County Consolidated Plan for Program Years 2020-24 and the one-year goals established in the Marin County Consolidated Plan Amendments (2022 Annual Action Plan) for the 2022-23 Program Year. The Consolidated Plan details the housing and non-housing needs of extremely low, very low, low, and moderate-income persons, and sets forth priorities and strategies for addressing these needs. The CAPER is to be submitted to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

Beginning on September 11, 2023 the draft CAPER for the 2022-23 Program Year will be available for public review through the Federal Grants website: [www.marincounty.org/federalgrants](http://www.marincounty.org/federalgrants).
