

Marin County Seeks Applicants Representing Racial and Ethnic Minorities and People with Disabilities for Membership on the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Priority Setting Committee

The County of Marin invites community residents to apply to be members of the Countywide Priority Setting Committee and its Local Area Committees. These committees oversee the distribution of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME Program funds in Marin County. The local governments in Marin have expanded the CDBG and HOME committees with the goal of increasing the diversity of these committees, and therefore this recruitment is specifically for individuals who represent the interests of racial and ethnic minorities and/or people with disabilities. The purpose of the expansion of the committees is to bring greater diversity to the group that (1) advises the Board of Supervisors on the CDBG and HOME funding allocation process and (2) provides input on the County's implementation of the Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing Choice.

Committee membership applications are due by 4:30 p.m. on September 25, 2013.
