RE: Decision regarding Parking lot/Driveway Asphalt Repair, 419 Drake Ave Marin City

MHA is proposing to remove and replace an area of worn/damaged asphalt driveway of an approximate size of 20 feet by 20 feet. The thickness and composition of asphalt layer will be recommended by the contractor. Removal of existing asphalt may require use of specialized equipment, machinery and vehicles (see attached Section 106 Undertaking Request for photos and additional details).

While the alignment of the driveways is considered a character-defining feature, the asphalt material used for the driveways is not character-defining (ICF 2019:5-27 and Appendix B page 12) nor are the driveway specified as an element of the historic district in the National Register nomination form (Ruark 2017). Therefore, the County determined that the replacement of asphalt, in kind, is considered a maintenance activity and does not affect the historic property under Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act. This decision is dependent on the understanding that no additional features (including curbing) would be modified as part of this project. This memo provides an administrative recordation of this decision and no further environmental review is necessary.
