



Want to inform how Marin County will spend Federal funding in the community?

The County of Marin invites Marin community residents to apply to serve on the Countywide Priority Setting Committee (PSC).

The PSC oversees the distribution of federal funds through the Community Development Block Grant program (CDBG) and HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME) to support a variety of community-based projects, including affordable housing, community facilities, and public services, such as childcare scholarships and services for individuals with disabilities.

There are three (3) openings on the PSC for community members representing the interests of racial and ethnic minorities and/or people with disabilities. Upon selection, committee member terms will go through Fall 2023.

This year the openings are for community members from the following regions including neighboring unincorporated areas of:

- Fairfax, Ross, San Anselmo
- Belvedere, Marin City, Mill Valley, Sausalito, Tiburon
- Countywide
