



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- White alone (Not Hispanic or Latino)

The index of isolation measures degree to which a certain demographic group is "isolated" within a neighborhood of people of the same demographic group. This figure ranges from 0% to 100% - higher values indicate more isolation of the group with its own members.



The values above indicate:

- → The average non-Hispanic White person in West Marin lives in a neighborhood¹ that is 86% percent non-Hispanic White.
- → The average non-Hispanic White person in Marin County lives in a neighborhood that is 76% percent non-Hispanic White.
- → The average Black person in West Marin lives in a neighborhood that is 1% percent Black.
- → The average Black person in Marin County lives in a neighborhood that is 9% percent non-Black.
- → The average Hispanic/Latino person in West Marin lives in a neighborhood that is 11% percent Hispanic/Latino.
- → The average Hispanic/Latino person in Marin County lives in a neighborhood that is 35% percent Hispanic/Latino.










Each map shows the percentile of the tract for the category amongst all census tracts in California.

Example: Socioeconomic Status shows the Canal tract 1122.01 is in the 80-100th percentile for the data points in this category, meaning rates for these factors are higher than 80-100% of census tracts throughout California.








Figure 9E: CDC Social Vulnerability Index – Housing Type & Transportation [TABLE-09]
