9:00 A.M. H1. USE PERMIT (UP 09-20): MARK PASTERNAK

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A proposal to consider the Pasternak Use Permit, proposing to amend an existing Use Permit for an agriculturally-related educational day camp at the Devil's Gulch Ranch located at 200 Road to Ranches in Nicasio. The project is a proposal to increase the number of students from 20 individuals to 50 individuals, to allow overnight camping for those students (ages ranging from 6 years old to 18 years old), and to allow up to 8 "events" for the promotion of agriculturally related land uses at the ranch. The project applicant is also requesting permission to conduct year-round day camps with a maximum of 20 participants a day with occasional overnight camping. The overnight portion of the camp would operate from June 14 until August 14 – a total of 9 weeks, for 6 days a week. The subject property is located at 200 and 210 Road to Ranches, Nicasio, and is further identified as Assessor's Parcels 121-070-66, -64 and -68.
