

**NOTICE OF MARIN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS HEARING  
Applications for Medical Cannabis Delivery-Only Retailer Licenses**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Marin County Board of Supervisors will consider approving the issuance of Medical Cannabis Delivery-Only Licenses for the following applications:

1. EXPRESS2YOU: Located at 76 San Pablo Avenue, San Rafael (APN 179-311-20)
2. BUTTERCUP AND SPRING: Located at 7 Mount Lassen Drive, San Rafael (APN 164-481-10)
3. ELITE HERBS: Located at 7 Mount Lassen Drive, San Rafael (APN 164-481-10)
4. MOJAVE DISTRIBUTION: Located at 7 Mount Lassen Drive, San Rafael (APN 164-481-10)

On November 14, 2017, the Board adopted Ordinance 3678 which established a regulatory framework to license up to four medicinal cannabis delivery-only retailers (MCDORe) in the unincorporated areas of the county in order to meet the medical needs of, and expand options for, patients to access medicinal cannabis. Four applicants submitted their Site Review applications in May for the final phase of the selection process. The proposed sites are located in the San Rafael Planning area, with one applicant (Express2You) proposing a premise within a commercial mixed-use building at 76 San Pablo Avenue, San Rafael, and three applicants (Buttercup & Spring, Elite Herbs, and Mohave Distribution) proposing separate premises within an office complex at 7 Mt. Lassen Drive, San Rafael.

The Board will consider allowing the issuance of MCDORe licenses to all of the separate applicants during a public hearing scheduled on **Tuesday, July 23, 2019**.

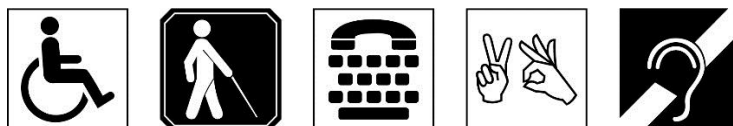

The Board of Supervisors hearing on the licenses will be held in the Marin County Hearing Chambers (Rooms 228/330, Administration Building), Civic Center, San Rafael, California, where anyone interested in this matter may appear and be heard. The time of the hearing will be indicated on the hearing agenda posted on the Board of Supervisors hearing webpage on the Thursday before the hearing. A staff report will be available on the Cannabis Programs webpage on Friday, July 19, 2019.

If you challenge the decision on these applications in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Community Development Agency, Planning Division during or prior to the public hearing. (Government Code Section 65009(b)(2).)
