Braden Lot Line Adjustment, 40 and 10 Popla Drive (Sihakom)

(Guest for project: Bruce Braden, owner, 40 Poplar)

Mr. Braden reviewed the application requesting permission to adjust the lot lines between two contiguous lots, as described in the following: an equitable exchange of 342 square feet of land would be transferred from a portion of APN 071-042-17 to APN 071-042-27, and 342 square feet of land would be transferred from a portion of APN 071-042-27 to APN 071-042-17. He noted this was a mutually agreeable swap which would allow modifications to his house to add space without having to encroach into a side setback.

Recommendation. M/S (Ross/John) and unanimously approved to recommend approval of the Braden lot line adjustment at 40 and 10 Poplar Drive, as submitted.
