Dear Marin County Planning Commissioners:

I write on behalf of New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC d/b/a AT&T Mobility (AT&T), to provide a corrected copy of AT&T's June 4, 2020 letter in support of its appeal from the Zoning Administrator's denial of AT&T's application to construct a wireless communications facility concealed as a bell tower at St. Luke Presbyterian Church at 10 Bayview Drive, San Rafael, CA in the County. Specifically, the attached letter is redlined to eliminate a statement that we have since learned was based on a misunderstanding as to negotiations between a resident and the church with respect to tree trimming.

This correction does not impact AT&T's rights under the Telecommunications Act of 1996, which form the basis for its appeal. The proposed facility offers the least intrusive means by which AT&T can close its significant gap in service coverage in this portion of the County. Additionally, AT&T remains willing to work with the County in regards to its facility design to help minimize any visual impacts. Thus, we reiterate AT&T's offer to construct either the shorter bell tower design as proposed or the somewhat taller and narrower bell tower that AT&T also presented as an alternative at County Staff's request.
