

NOTICE OF MARIN COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION HEARING
San Domenico School Development Plan Amendment

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Marin County Planning Commission will consider issuing a decision on the San Domenico School Development Plan Amendment during a public hearing scheduled on Monday, February 8, 2021. The applicants for the project are San Domenico School for Girls and the Sleepy Hollow Homes Association (SHHA), and the property is located at 1500 Butterflied Road, San Anselmo, further identified as Assessor's Parcel 176-300-30.

The applicants are requesting Development Plan amendment to modify the traffic management standards currently applicable to San Domenico School. The proposed amendment would increase daily and weekly trips to and from the campus, increase special events limitations, delete existing consequences to failure to comply with new terms, and reduce compliance audit frequency. The proposed changes are discussed in detail in the project description submitted with the application.

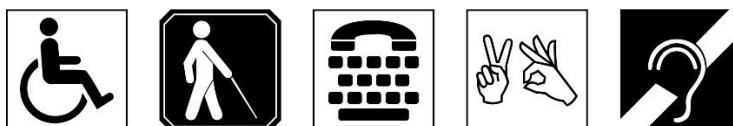
