2. Senate Bill 9

No substantive changes from interim Ordinances

3. Form Based Combining District

Implements Form Based Code

4. Housing Compliance Review

New ministerial permit



### Form Based Code Goals

- Address current and future legislation requirements including SB 35 and by-right housing approvals
- Promote Missing Middle Housing





### **ODDS** Initiative

## Objective Design and Development Standards:

- Funded by State grant to collaborate with Sausalito, Tiburon, Belvedere, Mill Valley, Corte Madera, Larkspur, Fairfax, San Anselmo, Novato, and Ross
- Opticos produced the ODDS for participating jurisdictions
- Opticos customized the ODDS to create the unincorporated County's Form Based Code
