You can apply water conservation strategies for indoor and outdoor use. These include:

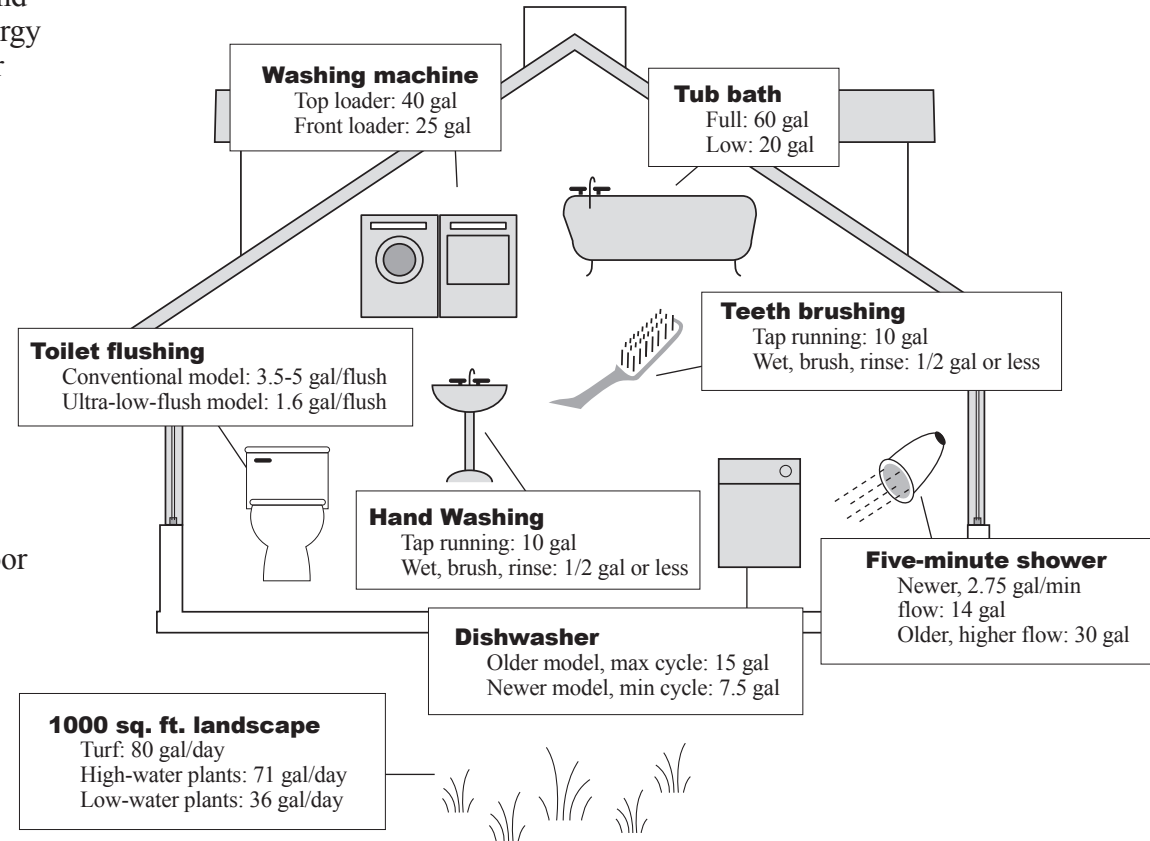
- Using water efficient fixtures and appliances
