- SchoolsRule raised \$951,750 in 2019; Tom Peters, CEO at Marin Community Foundation made a last minute contribution of \$48,250 to get SchoolsRule to the \$1 million mark for the year

 - Working on public art toolkit and resources for municipalities to promote art in their communities
 - Inventory of public art to develop data base, eventually an app to tour public art

• Feasibility study – initiated to identify needs and opportunities to improve programs at Marin Center in service of the cultural plan

- An RFP has gone out for a consultant to help with planning, programming and a facility feasibility study for the new facility masterplan
 - Proposals due beginning November; starting no later than December / January
- Goal #2: Marin Arts are by and for everyone
 - Reviewing current and upcoming programming: Black Beyond Borders exhibit;
 Dia de los Muertos; Best of SF Solo Series tickets offered to Commissioners
 - Irma Herrera was the first show; upcoming is Diane Barnes on November 10th at 7 PM
- Goal #3: Sustain and grow Marin's arts resources
 - MCA is exploring a possible sales or parcel tax initiative to fund arts grants & arts education; potentially facility work
 - Meeting with campaign consultant to assess community conditions and winning campaign
 - Researching existing programs & services for artists around the state and across the country marketing, training, convening, ticketing, fundraising, job and rental listings, as well as models for online and in-person program delivery.
 - Job listing created on marincultural.org; Tea is cleaning master list to send mass email and invite community to submit opportunities
