To be considered for the Marin County Fire Department's position of Firefighter OR Firefighter Paramedic, you must have a Cal-JAC CPAT card dated between November 9, 2019 to November 9, 2020 and pass the FCTC Written Test with a score of 70 or higher between November 9, 2019 to November 9, 2020.
