Dear Mr. Hamilton-Roth:

In response to the 2016 Marin County Grand Jury report on Human Trafficking, all Marin County District Attorney Inspectors have received training on Human Trafficking. Inspectors who had not previously attended the 8-hour Police Officers Standards and Training (POST) course entitled *Human Trafficking-Minors #9070-215177-12-006*, reviewed the most recent POST training DVD, *2014 Human Trafficking: Identify and Respond*. To further enhance this training, each member of the Bureau of Investigations, sworn and non-sworn, received and reviewed a copy of the 2015 Marin County protocol on Human Trafficking.

We also contacted the larger law enforcement agencies in the County (San Rafael Police Department, Central Marin Police Authority, Novato Police Department, Marin County Sheriff's Office) and learned that officers in these agencies have completed the POST training on Human Trafficking.

In addition, all full time regular-hire Deputy District Attorneys were trained on Marin County's Human Trafficking protocol and a copy of the protocol is posted on our internal computer system and available to all Deputy District Attorneys and Inspectors.
